Down to the wire? Here's our solution

Effective July 1, 2008 a person operating a moving motor vehicle while holding a wireless communication device to his or her ear is guilty of a traffic infraction. **The only exceptions are:**

1. An emergency vehicle, or tow truck responding to a disabled vehicle
2. A moving motor vehicle using a wireless device hands free
3. A moving motor vehicle using a hand-held device to:
 - Report illegal activity
 - Call for emergency help
 - Prevent injury to a person or property
4. Operating a moving motor vehicle while using a hearing aid

...none of these options work for you? Try our solution, rubber bands cost about 8 cents each.

Do you think you could recognize a stroke?

A neurologist says that if he can get to a stroke victim within 3 hrs. he can reverse the effects of a stroke. The trick is recognizing when a stroke is occurring and getting the patient medically cared for within these 3 hrs. which can be tough. Sometimes symptoms of a stroke can be hard to identify, but by following these 3 steps you could help save a life.

1. **"S"** - Ask the person to SMILE
2. **"T"** - Ask the person to TALK & speak a simple sentence (coherently)
3. **"R"** - Ask the person to RAISE both arms
4. **"NEW SYMPTOM"** - Ask the person to stick out their tongue. If the tongue is crooked or goes to one side or the other this can indicate a stroke
